PLEASE NOTE THE ITALIAN MAJOR IS NOT ADMITTING NEW STUDENTS AT THIS TIME. A minimum of fifty-five (55) credits of coursework (or equivalent) are required. A minimum grade of 2.0 is required in order for a course to be applied to the Italian major.

Courses

- Core: 20 credits from ITAL 203, ITAL 301, ITAL 302, and ITAL 304
- 10 credits (two courses) at the ITAL 350-level
- Electives: 25 credits above ITAL 203 from an approved list of electives. See adviser for approved list (excludes ITAL 127,199, 227, 299, and 327)
 - Must include 5 credits at the ITAL 400-level. Transfer credits at the 400 level only accepted by petition
- Minimum 15 credits in courses taught in Italian
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for courses applied to the major
- Maximum 15 credits of approved study-abroad coursework may be petitioned to apply to the major

Please note:

- ITAL 203, 301, 302, and 304 must be taken in sequence
- Courses at the ITAL 350 level have no prerequisites
- The prerequisite for 400-level Italian courses is completion of or concurrent enrollment in ITAL 302
