## Department of French & Italian Studies University of Washington Italian Undergraduate Major Requirements Effective Autumn 2015

A minimum of fifty-five (55) credits of coursework (or equivalent) are required at the 300- and 400-levels. A minimum grade of 2.0 is required in order for a course to be applied to the Italian major.

## **Courses**

- Core: 15 credits from ITAL 301, ITAL 302, ITAL 303; 10 credits from ITAL 304, ITAL 305, and ITAL 306; 5 credits at the ITAL 350-level
- Electives: 25 credits above ITAL 203 (excludes ITAL 127,199, 227, 299, and 327)
  - Must include 10 credits at the ITAL 400-level and an at least an additional 5 credits above ITAL 303
- Minimum 15 credits above ITAL 303 in courses taught in Italian
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for courses applied to the major
- Maximum 15 credits of approved study-abroad coursework may be petitioned to apply to the major

## Please note:

- ITAL 301, 302, and 303 must be taken sequentially
- The prerequisites for 300-level courses beyond 303 vary (some require 203, others require 302, for example). Please check the course catalog to see the prerequisite for a particular course.
- The prerequisite for 400-level Italian courses is completion of/concurrent enrollment in ITAL 303
