Thirty (30) approved credits above Italian 203 are required. It is important to note that Italian majors have priority over Italian minors when registering for upper level Italian courses. The Department of French & Italian Studies cannot guarantee that Italian minors will be able to complete their requirements in a timely manner.

Courses

- 15 credits from ITAL 301, ITAL 302, ITAL 303
- Two 5-credit courses at the ITAL 340- and ITAL 350-levels
- 5 credits above ITAL 203 (excludes ITAL 227, 234, 299, 327)
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for courses applied to the minor
- Maximum one course taught in English may be applied to the minor
- Maximum 10 credits of approved study-abroad coursework may be petitioned to apply to the minor
