G. Additional Information:

- ✓ The Masters Degree in Italian requires a minimum of 50 credits (excluding credits received for Italian 600), at least 30 of which must be at the 500 level in Italian.
- ✓ All M.A. students will receive 10 additional credits of Italian 600 for their independent study during the quarter in which they take their M.A. examinations.

 Alternatively, students may take 5 credits of Italian 600 in the quarter in which they take their M.A. examinations, and 5 credits in the preceding quarter.
- ✓ Please note: courses taken outside the department must be approved by the Graduate Program Coordinator prior to enrollment in order to be acceptable for fulfillment of requirements for the Masters in Italian.
- ✓ Proposals for independent study to fulfill graduate level requirements must be submitted in writing on the Independent Study Proposal form to the Graduate Program Coordinator, who will determine whether the project is acceptable to fulfill one of the program requirements based upon your prior academic performance and the merits of the proposal.
- ✓ Overall GPA of 3.6 must be maintained. Minimum acceptable grade for any course is 2.7.
