Foreign Language Requirement: proof of either high proficiency in a $3^{\rm rd}$ language, beyond French and English, or reading proficiency in a $4^{\rm th}$ language is required (which option will depend on the student's academic plans). This requirement is based on the

assumption that the student will have already acquired reading proficiency in a $3^{\rm rd}$ language in an MA program. Circle one of the following two options and indicate when this was completed: with date of exam or name and date of course. The foreign language requirement should be completed before the end of the $2^{\rm nd}$ PhD year.
Option 1 is completed through coursework in the 3 rd language – preferably at the 300 level or above. Date
Option 2 is completed by passing the reading proficiency exam administered by OEA and showing proof (as the case necessitates) of prior reading proficiency in a 3 rd language. Date
General Exam : the Supervisory committee must be appointed by spring of the 1 st year in the PhD Program (post MA). This committee consists of at least 3 members plus a Graduate School Representative (GSR). Information on the role of the GSR, plus a tool for finding eligible faculty to serve in this capacity, can be found at the Graduate School website: https://www.grad.washington.edu/policies/doctoral/gsr-eligibility.shtml . The exam will take place over 3 consecutive weekends, during which the student takes the written portion; and concludes with an oral exam (aka the General), in which the student will defend his/her written answers as well as present the beginnings of a dissertation topic.

Appointment of Reading Committee:

After the General Exam, the student appoints a Reading Committee of 3 members plus GSR. This Reading Committee will be the committee charged with reading and approval the dissertion prospectus and dissertation. The Reading Committee can be drawn from the Supervisory Committee. But membership on the Supervisory Committee *does not automatically* put one on the Reading Committee. The student must get written approval (forwarded to both the GPC and GPA) from the faculty member before naming him or her to the Reading Committee.
