French Undergraduate Minor Requirements
(effective Autumn 2011)

Thirty (30) approved credits above French 203 are required. It is important to note that French majors have priority over French minors when registering for upper level French courses. The Division of French & Italian Studies cannot guarantee that French minors will be able to complete their requirements in a timely manner.

Courses

- French 301, 302, 303* Advanced Syntax and Composition (5,5,5) (15 credits)
- **One of the following survey courses:**
 - French 304 Survey of French Literature: Origins to 1600 (5 credits)
 - French 305 Survey of French Literature: 1600-1789 (5 credits)
 - French 306 Survey of French Literature: 1789-Present (5 credits)
 - French 307 Survey of Francophone Literature (5 credits)
- 376 Culture, Politics, and Society in France from the Religious Wars to Revolutions (5 credits)
or
French 378 The Making of Contemporary France (5 credits)
- 5 elective credits above 203, excluding 207, 227, 234, 237, 297, 299, 327, and 337.

A minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA is required for courses applied toward the minor.

Note: Up to 10 credits taken abroad may be counted toward the minor. These credits can be 301, 302, 303 or a survey literature course.
